

Worship in the Cathedral of God's Creation



St. Luke's Outdoor Eucharist service by the Eno River: October 15, 2011 4 p.m.

Our "procession" to worship will involve a 15 minute walk along a gently rolling trail to a quiet spot along the river. Dress appropriately for weather and walking. In case of heavy rain, we may cancel (notice will be posted on the church door and on our website). Bring a blanket or lightweight chair/stool if you wish. All ages and guests welcome. This is part of our celebration of the feast of St. Luke, the physician, as we focus on being healers of God's creation.

Directions

Meet at St. Luke's at 3:45 to carpool (encouraged to reduce parking crowding) –OR-
meet at the Eno State Park Pump Station Trailhead (lower entrance at bridge).

From St. Luke's: Turn left (north) out of church parking lot. Proceed to Carver Street stoplight and turn left.

Turn left at stoplight on Rose of Sharon Rd then right at light on Cole Mill Rd.

Follow Cole Mill and turn right on RIVERMONT RD (if you reach Sparger Rd. stoplight you just missed it)

Proceed on RIVERMONT past the first Pump Station Trailhead, down the hill to a bridge and the lower trailhead on the left (look for the sign). Park along the road. An usher will be at the lower trailhead to guide you.
