Some fun facts...In the mid 1920's, a few cuttings from a plant native to Mexico provided the start of an enduring holiday tradition. Joel Roberts Poinsett, the first American ambassador to Mexico, grew the cuttings after returning to his South Carolina greenhouse. The plant was later given the name Poinsettia to honor Poinsett for introducing the plant to the US.

The Poinsettias are available in red, marble, pink and white in 6", 8" and 10". Pot covers in gold are also available. We will have two delivery dates: November 20<sup>th</sup> for those of you who would like them as a hostess gift for your Thanksgiving Weekend, or December 4<sup>th</sup> at the Alternative Gifts Fair. All plants must be picked up at St. Luke's.
